At Barnett Elementary we will...



- Allow students to be rewarded for good work ethic and conduct grades

- Practice 7 Mindsets daily





HEADLINE TITLE

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
Once the image you wish to replace is selected, you can either select “Change Picture” from the short cut menu, or click on the “Fill” option and choose the option for “Picture.”


If you replace a photo with your own and it’s not a flawless fit for the space, you can crop it to fit in almost no time. Just select the picture and then, on the Picture Tools Format tab, click Crop.



HEADLINE TITLE

You can easily change the overall colors of the template with just a few clicks. Go to the Design tab and click on Colors. From the list of colors, you





can choose a different color scheme. As you hover over the different choices, you can see what the overall feel of the document will change with each different option.
