Proclamation  
**National School Bus Safety Week**

**WHEREAS**, approximately 3,672 students are transported on school buses daily in the Santa Fe School District;  
and

**WHEREAS**, over 20,000 passenger trips are provided annually; and

**WHEREAS**, 36 buses operate over 124 routes on a daily basis; and

**WHEREAS**, school buses in Santa Fe School District travel over 454,250 miles annually; and

**WHEREAS**, school bus drivers are required to receive a minimum of 40 hours of training before they are issued a school bus driver's certification; and

**WHEREAS**, all transportation employees receive additional training on an annual basis; and

**WHEREAS**, 52 bus drivers, special education bus attendants, mechanics, office and management staff are dedicated to providing safe transportation for the children in this community; and

**WHEREAS**, school bus drivers safely operate school buses under difficult driving conditions for a large portion of the school year; and

**WHEREAS**, Santa Fe School District's first priority in the transportation program is the safety of students;

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Santa Fe School District observe the week of October 17-21, 2016, as School Bus Safety Week.
