



A Resolution Recognizing October 19-23, 2015 as National School Bus Safety Week

Whereas, approximately 3,500 students are transported on school buses daily in the Santa Fe School District; and

Whereas, over 20,000 passenger trips are provided annually; and

Whereas, 50 buses operate over 124 routes on a daily basis; and

Whereas, school buses in Santa Fe School District travel over 450,000 miles annually; and

Whereas, school bus drivers are required to receive a minimum of 40 hours of training before they are issued a school bus driver's certification; and

Whereas, all transportation employees receive additional training on an annual basis; and

Whereas, 49 bus drivers, special education bus attendants, mechanics, office and management staff are dedicated to providing safe transportation for the children in this community; and

Whereas, school bus drivers safely operate school buses under difficult driving conditions for a large portion of the school year; and

Whereas, Santa Fe School District's first priority in the transportation program is the safety of students;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Santa Fe School District observe the week of October 19-23, 2015 as School Bus Safety Week.
