

Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs

The district offers career and technical education programs in the following areas:

- Agriculture, Food, & Natural Resources
- Architecture and Construction
- Arts, Audio Video Technology and Communications
- Business Management and Administration
- Health Science
- Hospitality & Tourism
- Law, Public Safety, Corrections, and Security
- Manufacturing

Public Service Admission to these programs is based on student interest, age appropriateness and space availability. Santa Fe ISD will take steps to ensure that lack of English language skills will not be a barrier to admission and participation in all educational and CTE programs. Admission to these programs is based on student course selection, teacher availability, and class availability in the student's schedule. Please note that not all CTE courses offered may make minimum enrollment requirements and are based on the number of courses selected by students. It is the policy of the district not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap in its vocational programs, services, or activities as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.
