SFISD Technology Department is excited to start off the 2022-2023 school year and welcome all staff and students.

The district 1:1 laptop program has a few changes this year. No personal laptops will be permitted during the school day and only secondary students in **grades 7-12** will be issued district laptops/chargers. Laptop distribution will begin the week of August 15th and laptop cases will be issued to all students as soon as they arrive from the manufacturer. A \$20 insurance fee will be applied to student Skyward fees (waived for students that qualify for Free/Reduced lunch). If you would like to apply for Free/Reduced lunch status, please visit the YUM!
