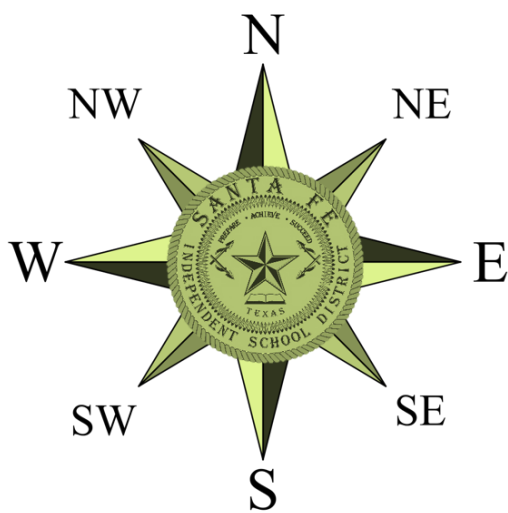

# FACTS

## SFISD AND THE ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM

All results in the accountability system are based upon state standardized test performance.



"What if" ratings were published had the district counted in accountability

**Domain 1:**  
District receives a point for each student in Approaching Grade Level, Meeting Grade Level, and Mastering Grade Level in STAAR.

**Domain 2 Part A and Part B:**  
Part A: Measures growth in Reading and/or Math  
Part B: Measure campus relative performance of students with other campuses with similar Economic Disadvantaged percentages on STAAR Testing.

**Domain 3: Closing the Gaps in STAAR**  
This counts for 30% of the district's accountability. It pertains to various student groups with 25 student minimum size requirement.



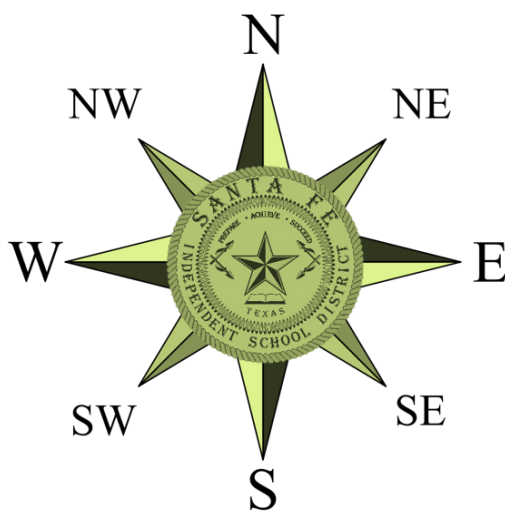
2018 SFISD received a 'Not Rated' due to Hurricane Harvey Provision

SFISD, if rated, would have been classified as MET STANDARD with improvements in all areas in this Domain. This Domain counts as 70% of SFISD's Accountability.

SFISD, and all other Texas schools, was given the "Best Of" Domain 1 or Domain 2 for the 70% Accountability Rating.

SFISD shows patterns of growth and gap closure in various sub-pops but this Domain requires additional focus in specific groups. Targeted strategies are being planned to assist our English Second Language, Special Education, and Economically Disadvantaged student test scores.

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### **Texas Education Agency, Accountability, and Santa Fe ISD**

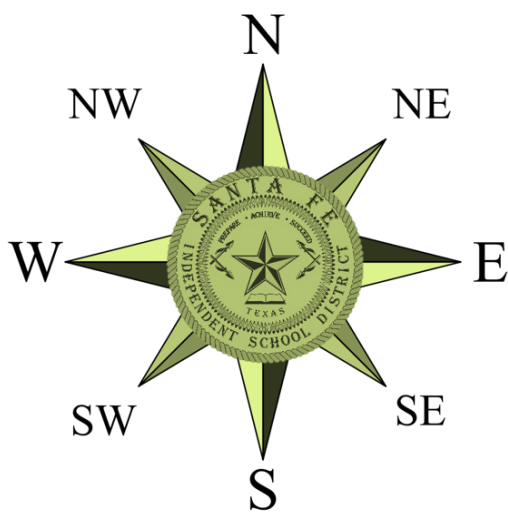
Santa Fe ISD is a state facility providing public education. TEA is the state agency providing support and guidance to ALL public schools.

When we see patterns of inconsistencies, we are required to conduct a root cause analysis to analyze and pinpoint what targets need to be addressed in our educational action plan.

Texas Education Agency and our State Service Center, Region 4, provides us support in conducting these Focused Data Analysis and Aligned Strategy Identification so we create a comprehensive plan to close the gaps.

Santa Fe ISD is given support by our state but in the same way all districts receive this support. As for questions about resources, resources and training for ALL state tested and non-tested subjects are provided. Selection of resources in Santa Fe ISD support the needs of all students enrolled in these courses and are selected based upon proper alignment with state standards.

## OVERVIEW OF STATE ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM

### Domain 1

**STEP 1** SCHOOLS AND DISTRICTS ARE GRADED IN 3 DIFFERENT AREAS, OR DOMAINS. We look at performance in each domain to determine an overall grade.

Example Grades:

- STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT: 74
- SCHOOL PROGRESS: 83
- CLOSING THE GAPS: 89

Santa Fe ISD Met Standard in this Domain at each campus.

### Domain 2

**STEP 2** DETERMINE THE BETTER GRADE OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT OR SCHOOL PROGRESS. Whichever domain score is higher of the two will count as 70% of the overall grade. The domain score that is lower will not be factored in to the overall grade.

Since 83 is a higher grade than 74, the School Progress grade will be used for 70% of the overall grade.

We received "Best of" Domain 1 or 2, and we scored higher in Domain 1. However, we are still creating district and campus plans to target this Domain in order to reach ALL students.

### Domain 3

**STEP 3** COMBINE SCORE FROM STEP 2 WITH THE CLOSING THE GAPS SCORE. The better of Student Achievement or School Progress will count for 70% of the overall grade. The Closing the Gaps score will count for 30%.

70% Better of: Student Achievement or School Progress

30% Closing the Gaps

= Overall Grade B 85
