*** The Middle of the Year Assessments serve as a benchmark for our students. The purpose of the assessment is to determine how your child is progressing with grade level curriculum and is an indicator of success on the STAAR (State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness). The Middle of the Year Assessments do NOT count as a grade. Teachers will use this data as they make goals for instruction to ensure your child is well prepared for the STAAR test. Your child will also have a chance to look at their test and make personal academic goals. Please speak with your child about doing their best on these assessments! More information to come!
